## How do I log in to ProQuest Dialog?

You can log in from the [ProQuest Dialog Customer Information](#) site using the unique User ID and Password provided by your Account Manager. Get a quick start by establishing a **My Research** account, a personal work space that will allow you to


- Log in to Dialog from any location using your My Research account sign-in details.
- Store documents and previous searches for future reference.
- Organize saved documents into different folders.
- Set preferences for search results, citation style and language.
